



Slovenija je u posljednja 24 sata registrirala 666 novih slučajeva zaraze koronavirusom, što je 103 manje nego prije tjedan dana, a od COVID-19 umrlo je još sedam osoba, čime se ukupan broj umrlih popeo na 5542, objavio je u nedjelju Nacionalni institut za javno zdravstvo. Neke projekcije govore da bi se mogao očekivati □□ novi uzlazni trend epidemije zbog brzog širenja Omicron varijante virusa tipa XBB.1.16. odnosno **Arcturusa**.

Stopa pozitivnosti testa bila je 30,9 posto, a sedmodnevni prosjek slučajeva bio je 1069 po danu. Broj aktivnih slučajeva trenutačno je 16.072, a na bolničkom liječenju je 577 zaraženih, uključujući 197 na intenzivnoj njezi. Simptomi infekcije tzv. Omicron virusom koja uglavnom zahvaća mlađu dob su povišena temperatura, svrbeža i *konjunktivitisa*, te se razmatra ponovno uvođenje zaštitnih epidemioloških mjera.

A new type of omicron coronavirus discovered in India

Citing this institute, local media reports that the Omicron variant could account for 60% of new COVID infections. India has seen an increase in Covid cases in recent times. States like Delhi and Maharashtra have seen a rise in cases. The report said around 60% of the 2023 Covid-related deaths in Maharashtra were reported in the first two weeks of April alone,

Hindustan Times reported citing data compiled by the state's health department. The country has recorded as many as 60 Covid-related deaths since the start of 2023. Of these 60, 36 were recorded between April 1 and 15, while the other 24 were recorded between January and March. Officials claim that most of the deceased were elderly and had accompanying illnesses.
